Solar Panels

Time to install the panels to off-set our electricity costs. We have two supporters, both with solar panel supply and fit companies, and both members of the Building Fund, and both employing members of the club, to request quotes from. Obviously we could only appoint one to the task. The appointed contractor is **Frank Pezzaniti**. Once funding and the appropriate permits are finalised, we will have 60 panels on the roof and 3 x 5kw inverters in the eastern stairwell. This will significantly reduce our costs for electricity. We now have three periods of electricity accounts to calculate our usage and the known average cost is about \$70.00 per day, open or not. I will put the specifications on our **new Notice Board!**
