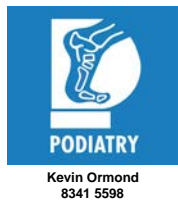

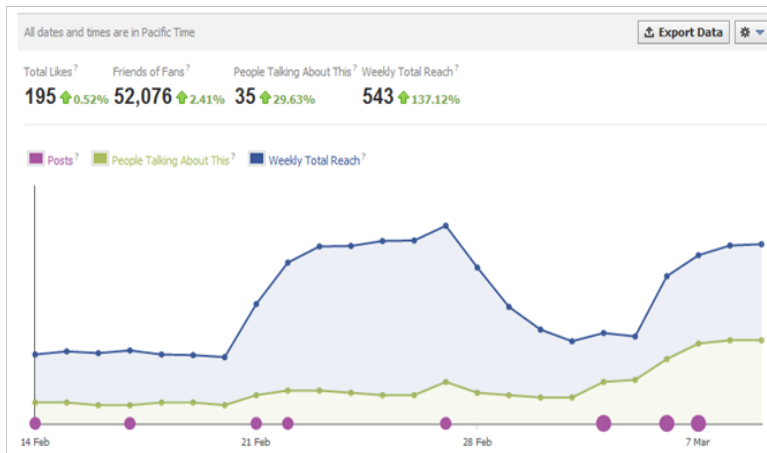

### NIGHT-vision security cameras are set to be installed at St Kilda to catch thieves and arsonists.

A Salisbury Council committee last night voted to fund \$47,000 for the high-tech cameras at the entrance of St Kilda, the adventure playground, along Fooks Tce, the boat ramp and the carpark.
