New liquor licensing code of practice:

RSA training will be mandatory for all bar servers at venues with a Club Licence from 18th January 2013 (this Friday). The new code will impact many clubs like ours, and all clubs (regardless of licence type) will need to conduct a risk assessment and create a written management plan to show how they mitigate those risks. We lead off with a training session: Monday, 25th February (6:00pm -10:00pm) In the Clubrooms. Course costs \$50.00 p/p (for Good Sports accredited clubs) and training is open to younger members (e.g. 16-17) who will also greatly benefit.
