Best on ground this week: Kale Christopher.

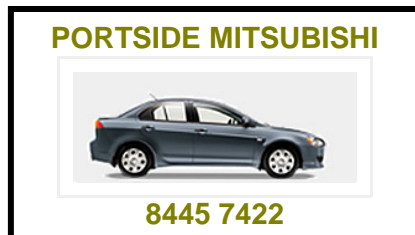

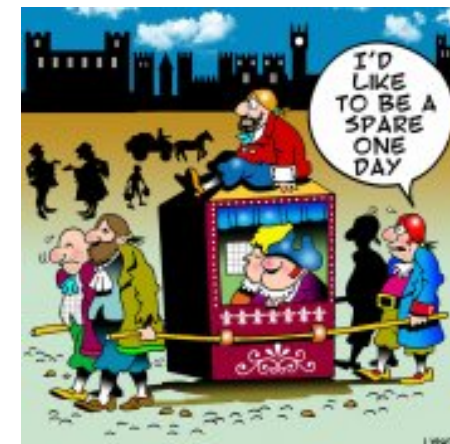
