

DISAPPOINTING END TO 2013

Well, the season came to a conclusion last Saturday. We looked reasonable early and fell away in the final quarter. Shaun Jacobsen stopped everything for the first 15 minutes and we were on top, going into the reasonably strong wind – 3 to 4 goals. But then WOS got a run on and in the end had a good break at quarter time. We only went into attack on a couple of occasions with Josh Vines able to raise full points. Our second quarter was a poor one. With the breeze we were unable to capitalize. WOS perhaps had the pressure on, but our main problem was self induced. Turnovers cost us dearly. For the entire game we suffered what was probably our worst effort as regards to missing targets. Giving our forwards any chance of marking was negated by poor disposal. In fact I don't think we took a mark in the forward 50! At half time we were struggling. Our third quarter was our best. Into the conditions we outscored WOS (admittedly they were a little off target), but our defence got on top and was nullifying their strong points. Tyson Thomas to full back and Adam Rumbelow to back pocket shut down what had been strong points. The final quarter and we were coming home with the breeze at our backs and four goals down – with (now) a 2 to 3 goal advantage.

It looked as if we could do it. But not to be. WOS rallied and turned the tables, outscoring us against the fading wind! It was a disappointing end to what has been a good season, one in which we offered a lot until the last few matches.

Brad Horsell announced his retirement as coach – a couple of weeks ago – and now we must look to 2014 – to move up a division. We have a lot of things going for us – not the least being the nucleus of a very good side.
